The WAA acts as an umbrella organisation looking after the interests of the following constituent groups:



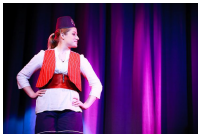
Genesis Youth Theatre Group

Our award winning Youth Theatre Group was founded in 1996 with the purpose of introducing young people to all aspects of the performing arts. Members must be between 11 and 16 and the group meet weekly during the school term time



Spectrum Arts & Crafts

Spectrum are the art & craft section of the WAA. They meet at the Arts Centre every week. Talks, demonstrations and workshops are arranged occasionally with an annual exhibition at the Arts Centre. Visitors are always welcome.



Wellington Pantomime Group

Our multi-award winning pantomime group produces a week long annual show which is staged at our 400 seat Wellesley Theatre in Wellington. The group has won many awards since it was founded back in 1975, including the prestigious Cinderella Trophy.



Wellington Operatic Society

The Operatic Society stage an annual musical at the Wellesley Theatre, as well as a cabaret show of their own devising each autumn at the Arts Centre. They also provide entertainment to other organisations and at other local events.



Wellington Theatre Company (The Civic Players)

The Wellington Theatre Company, previously known as The Civic Players, form the dramatic side of the association, staging dramas, comedies, plays and farces at the Arts Centre, often choosing to tackle complex and interesting shows.



Wellington Acoustic Music Club

The acoustic music club meets at the Arts Centre on the third Saturday of every month from 8:30pm until 11pm. Catering for all styles and types of music, from beginners to professionals, all are welcome to come along and listen or join in.
